Fall Fest Chili Cook-off - October 30th

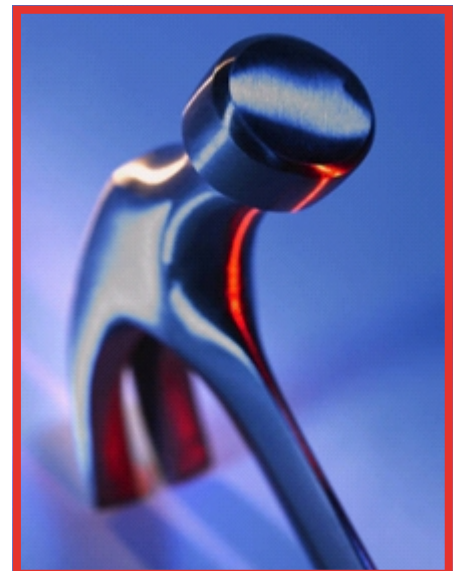
Get the caldrons out, pick your chili peppers and cook up your favorite recipe for the Fall Fest Chili Cook-off.

LANDSCAPE HINTS

Plant

It's not too late to plant annual color! Early June does not usually suffer from intense heat and warm soil is abundant for such plants as Caladiums who need it.

Prune

Only prune shrubs and vines as needed for shape after they have finished blooming.

Feed

Plants need food, too! Slow release fertilizers offer great results. One to try is Colorscares.

Water

Keep in mind, watering deeply but less often is better than watering everyday for a short time. Also turf requires more water than flower or shrubs.

Clean, sparkling pools aren't just attractive, they're healthy! Keeping our pools pristine takes a commitment from everyone. These are all fabulous ways to optimize your Savannah lifestyle - take advantage of them all.

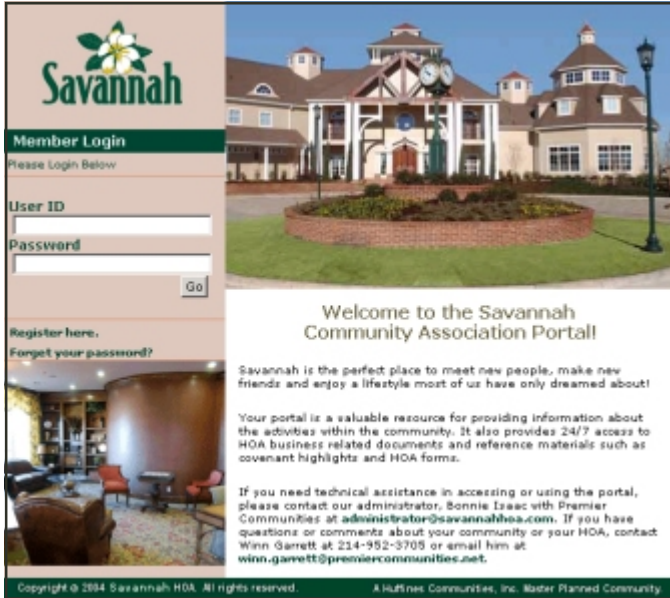
Committees are a big part of your Savannah lifestyle, in fact these will be the backbone of the community.

DENTON COUNTY NEWS DESK

Budget preparation has begun in earnest. While final decisions of Commissioners Court takes place later in July, many hours of work are currently contributing to the overall process.

The budget process at the county is complex and includes participation by many. The department heads and elected officials submit a budget request to the Budget Department. Our Budget Director, Donna Stewart, along with her staff, sift through it with general parameters in mind that have been delineated by the Court (one parameter has been to bring a budget to the Court that does not require a tax increase). Then Ms. Stewart presents the preliminary budget to the Commissioners Court and we begin our work.

Keep in mind that you have four Commissioners and one County Judge who may or may not have similar philosophies and end goals in mind. All this makes for lively conversation, to say the least!

Each member of the Commissioners Court is free to bring their ideas to the table. For example, the County Judge has submitted her ideas for Library funding. Her ideas are not "set in stone," however. While the Judge's proposal will be discussed, there are four other perspectives that will shape the outcome.

Budget seasons are tough. In addition to the competing visions for county government, we face many challenges; the explosive growth, the economy, rising health care costs, unfunded mandates and others. Limited resources force us to make tough decisions. From my perspective, I work to prioritize the needs based on providing the essentials of county government and work out from there. I have been a strong supporter of library funding in the past and continue to believe that library funding provides a critical need in our communities. While I believe the county can provide seed funding for our libraries, every year we must scrutinize every expenditure against the backdrop of the big picture and outside forces that are constantly in a state of change. I will continue to work to provide for county government needs in the most efficient and cost-effective manner possible and welcome input from citizens during the entire process.
